Children of Hangzhou: Connecting with China

Occurs at: Boston Children's Museum

Location: 300 Congress Street, Boston

"Meet" four children from Hangzhou and join them at home, at school, in the library, in the theater, and in the countryside environments. The Hangzhou young people will introduce themselves through media and the activities of their daily lives. Visitors will discover that Chinese life today mixes ancient traditions with modern lifestyles, and that life in China is both similar to and different from life in North America. The young Chinese in the exhibit will be a bridge to learning about China and building cross-cultural understanding. The exhibit features original artwork created to present a unique Chinese aesthetic that delivers an immediate and unmistakable impression: You are in China.
